Ken Wheeler's set design was simple, but awe inspiring at the same time. The rest of the stage production team was always right on the money. Thanks to ChrisTucker who designed lighting and Peter Kobor who took time from his busy schedule as director of Studio Arts Entertainment to help out. Jeremy Hammond pulled all of the folks on the production team together very nicely as stage manager. The costume team of Lorraine, Sherry, Sharlene and Terry did a marvelous job making the girls look authentically from the 1950's. The dresses were simply gorgeous in their pastel sherbet colors. Each character, naïve and otherwise, was well established by director DebbiTerrio. Choreographer, Joann Searles had those backup singers pop right out of a concert from 1955. Deana Tracy is house manager for the AdirondackTheater Festival and is working at the YMCA summer camps for music and drama.




Bev McKim performed in GFCT production of *The Women*.
